Affirmative Development of Academic Ability

Professor Gordon is concerned with issues associated with increasing the number of high academic achieving students who come from African American, Latino, and Native American families. He is widely known for his research on diverse human characteristics and pedagogy, and the education of low status populations. Recent research interests include the advancement of his concepts of "affirmative development of academic ability" and "supplementary education" which focus on improving the quality of academic achievement in diverse learners. His current study group on the *Correlates of High Academic Achievement* is investigating personal, ecological, and institutional factors that are associated with high levels of academic achievement in a variety of ethnic minority students.
