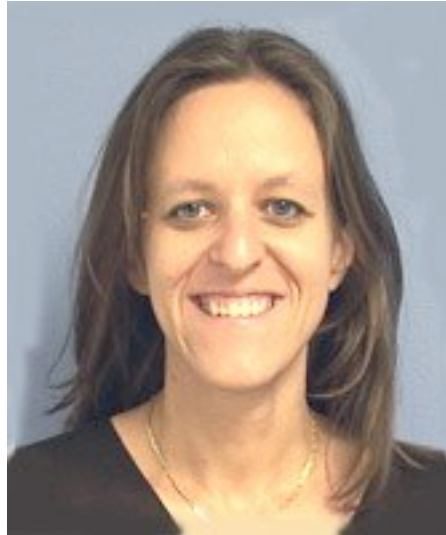


MPES Visiting Speaker: Rossella Santagata

Educational Researcher Rossella Santagata focuses on mathematics teaching and learning in different cultures and the use of multimedia technology for teacher learning and professional development. She uses methods ranging from case studies, ethnography and discourse analysis to pre- and post- test comparisons and experimental and quasi-experimental studies. Santagata is currently working on an experimental study of a video-based teacher professional development program for pre-algebra teachers. She is Assistant Professor in the Department of Education at University of California, Irvine, and is on the faculty at the Scuola di Specializzazione all'Insegnamento Secondario in Rome, Italy. Rossella received a Laura degree in Developmental and Educational Psychology from the University of Padua, Italy, and an MA and PhD in Development Psychology from the University of California, Los Angeles.
