Co-PI Data Acquisition and Analysis Center - NICHD Study of Early Child Care and Youth Development

This NICHD collaborative multi-site study examines the relationships between child development and child care during infancy and early childhood into adolescence.

This multi-site center is designed to address important issues in early childhood education.

The major goal of this project is to identify risk and protective factors in academic development for African American children in the NICHD SECCYD.

This project demonstrates the feasibility and utility of integrated qualitative and quantitative analyses using data from three large, recently funded, longitudinal studies of child development during the first five years of life.
